The effluent is filtered water quality with reduced PFAS. Discharge rates are being recorded and submitted to the FTSA monthly for review and billing purposes. The pilot study began on June 24, 2024 with a continuous discharge of approximately 10,000 - 14,000 gpd for 9-12 months. The study is ongoing.
