27. Industrial Billing / Metering: New Jersey American Water requested temporary discharge approval for a pilot study testing various PFAS treatment medias. The effluent is filtered water quality with reduced PFAS. Discharge rates are recorded and submitted to the FTSA monthly for review and billing purposes. The pilot study began on June 24, 2024 with a continuous discharge of approximately 10,000 - 14,000 gpd. Originally approved by the FTSA for one (1) year, NJAW WTP requested to extend their PFAS removal Pilot Study to October 2025. The study is ongoing.
